There are many, many 'jobs' in the parish, that are increasingly being done by an ever-smaller group of volunteers. Please read the list below, and see if there is something you would like to get involved in. The more help we have, the smaller the burden on any one individual. **SUNDAY COFFEE**

Many of you enjoy stopping for coffee in the parish hall after the Sunday Mass. Are you one of those parishioners? The coffee rota involves setting up the tables and chairs in the Hall before Mass, serving the drinks, and then clearing up afterwards.

PARISH LUNCH

The monthly parish lunches have been running for years, and make a very valuable contribution to the community aspect of our parish. The Parish Lunch rota involves cooking and serving a 2-course lunch to around 25 parishioners, including setting up the hall beforehand, and clearing away. We are especially short of helpers to assist with the serving and washing up.

VACANCIES ON THE PARISH COUNCIL

After many years on the council, Clare Reed and Bernie Hassim have stepped down from their roles as Ecumenical and Youth co-ordinators, and these vacancies need to be filled. READERS AND EUCHARISTIC MINISTERS

As always, we are looking out for new faces to swell the ranks of these teams, young as well as older ones. ALTAR SERVERS

Do any of the young people who have taken their First Holy Communion and Confirmation in the last few years want to get more involved in the Parish? If so helping out on the Altar is a great way to do it.

CHOIR AND YOUTH MASS

Do you like to sing? Can you play or are you learning to play an instrument? Please go and say 'hi' to the choir before or after Mass and have a chat. SOUND SYSTEM AND LAP TOP OPERATORS

The AV system has been up and running for several years now, and the operating instructions are simple and easy to follow. The rota needs both adults to oversee the system, and younger parishioners to operate the laptop and screen.

CHILDRENS LITURGY

Have your children enjoyed attending the Children's liturgy, or do you have younger ones who will be attending in the future? The children's liturgy team read a short prayer and the gospel, before helping the children fill out a worksheet. This is a term time only role.

SVP

The St Vincent de Paul Society – or SVP for short – offers people the means to give a little of their time to helping others who are in need. Our Parish SVP group meets twice a month. USHERS

The ushers welcome people into church, hand out Mass books and the newsletter, and take up the collection. **JUSTICE & PEACE GROUP**

This is combined with other Parishes in the pastoral area, to support CAFOD, MoPSA and other deserving causes. It deals also with current national and international problems.
