

Covid-19 Route Map: The Catholic Bishop's Conference of England and Wales have released the latest guidelines for the liturgical celebrations after 19th July. A few copies are kept in the porch, please look at them for more information. Some highlights include: wearing face-cover is optional, no social distancing required, singing is permitted, social gathering is allowed, no number restriction for baptisms, funerals, stewarding is no longer required, no booking needed. However, each church should assess the situation in the particular area with regard to infection rate and take maximum care in implementing these relaxations. Communion will be given only in one species, no Holy Water stoups, no shaking hands during exchange of peace. Please continue to sanitize your hands as you enter the church, please use the side chapel in St. Aidan's for those who wish to keep social distancing. It is also recommended that while singing, we use face cover. Collection plates can be used and Children's Liturgy will commence soon. We might still keep a track and trace paper, to leave your name and contact number or email. I request everyone to come back to the Church for regular worship.
