**A word from Fr. Ken:** Last Sunday *MOPSA* (Missionaries of the Poor Supporters Association) held a postponed celebration of my 90th birthday and 60th year of Priesthood. The event included a lunch, the sharing of some of the good events of the past years, over a million pounds collected by MOPSA for the mission, and a Rowan tree, known as *'The Tree of Life'* (and symbolising courage, wisdom and protection), planted near the statue of St. Aidan. It was all a great surprise and much appreciated and my thanks go to all concerned.
