
Covid-19 Route Map: We have received an updated version of the document from the Catholic Bishop's Conference of England and Wales, which exhorts everyone to follow certain guidelines in our Churches and for the worship. They insist on wearing face cover inside the Church, especially during singing. Sanitize your hands as you enter the Church and if anyone want to keep social distance, please take the "Leave a space" card and keep next to the place where you sit. Alternately, for those in St. Aidan's can use the side chapel for sitting separately. Singing is permitted, social gathering is allowed, no number restriction for baptisms, funerals, stewarding is no longer required but welcomers are expected to stand at the main entrance, no booking needed. However, each church should assess the situation in the particular area with regard to infection rate and take maximum care in implementing these relaxations. Communion will be given only in one species, no Holy Water stoups, no shaking hands during exchange of peace. Collection plates can be used and Children's Liturgy will commence from the first week of August. We might still keep a track and trace paper, please leave your name and contact number or email. I request everyone to come back to the Church for regular worship.
