All Saints Day: This Sunday, we celebrate the solemnity of All Saints. It is a Holy Day of Obligation. All Souls Day: On *Tuesday, 2nd November*, we celebrate the solemnity of All Souls. On this day, we not only remember the dead, but we apply our efforts, through prayer, almsgiving, and the Mass, to their release from Purgatory. Praying for the dead is a Christian obligation. There will be mass at Our Lady's at 9.30am and St. Aidan's at 7.00pm, followed by blessing of the grave (The small plot where the ashes are buried). On Tuesday, 2nd November, I will bless the graves at Stanley Hill Cemetery at 11.30am. Families whose members are buried there, please be present.

Offering Mass for the Dead: When we face the death of someone, even a person who is not Catholic, to have a Mass offered for the repose of his/her soul and to offer our prayers are more beneficial and comforting than any other sympathy card or bouquet of flowers. Most importantly, we should always remember our own dearly departed loved ones in the Holy Mass and through our own prayers and sacrifices to help in their gaining eternal rest. The Masses in November will be celebrated for the Holy Souls, unless specific intentions are asked. Please pick up the Holy Souls envelopes and drop it in the box kept Infront of the Altar.
